The current concept of ESG lacks the necessary measure to capture the enterprises' economic and social impacts as well as the sustainable values created for different stakeholders. Currently, many businesses take the perspective that ESG is mainly to satisfy regulatory requirements. Therefore, Prof Simon S.M.
